<b>FACTS</b>	WHAT DOES <b>PAUL COMSTOCK PARTNERS</b> DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
<b>Why?</b>	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
<b>What?</b>	<p>The types of personal information we collect, and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Social Security Number and driver's license number</li> <li>Account balances and income</li> <li>Addresses and contact information</li> </ul> <p>When you are no longer our client, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.</p>
<b>How?</b>	All financial companies need to share client's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their client's personal information; the reasons Paul Comstock Partners chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• Affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you</li> </ul> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
<b>Definitions</b>	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p><i>Paul Comstock Partners has no affiliates.</i></p>
Non affiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p><i>These include broker/dealers, mutual fund companies, insurance companies and other financial institutions.</i></p>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p><i>Paul Comstock Partners does not do joint marketing.</i></p>
